How to donate



The Sudan Humanitarian Fund (SHF) is a cost-effective way to support humanitarian action in Sudan. Under the direction of the Humanitarian Coordinator (HC), the SHF aims to support the timely allocation and disbursement of donor resources to the most critical humanitarian needs as defined by the Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) or any agreed upon strategy by the HC. The SHF provides funding to international and national non-governmental organizations and UN agencies. The SHF receives voluntary donor contributions and supports humanitarian response year-round.

TAKE ACTION!

The United Nations Office of the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) has teamed up with United Nations Foundation to collect online donations for the SHF.

▶ **Institutional donors** that wish to contribute to the SHF can sign a Standard Administrative Arrangement (SAA) with the **UNDP Multi-Partner Trust Fund (MPTF)** Office in New York.

▶ **Individuals, corporations & foundations** can donate online on **unocha.org/sudan** through the United Nations Foundation website.

The **MPTF office** maintains a website for the Sudan HPF which contains up-to-date information on donor contributions, funded projects, disbursements to UN agencies and to NGOs, and annual expenditures.

The MPTF office is a UN center of expertise on pooled financing mechanisms. It supports development effectiveness and UN coordination through the efficient, accountable and transparent design and administration of innovative pooled financing mechanisms.




