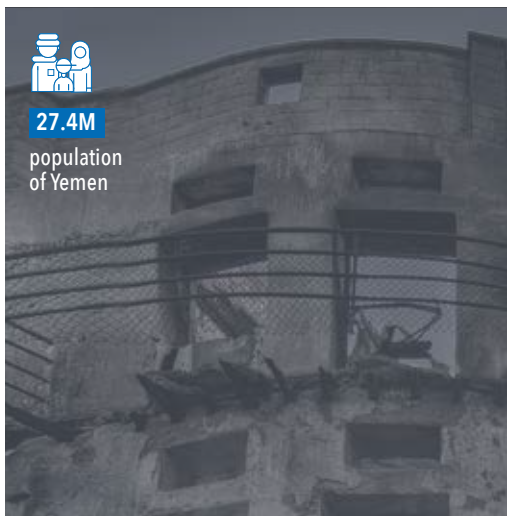
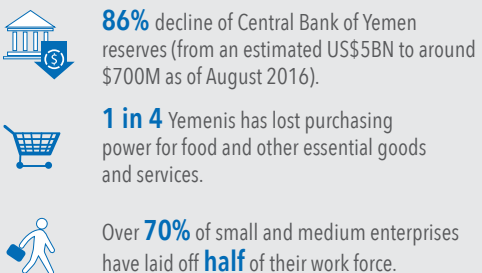
Impact on the population

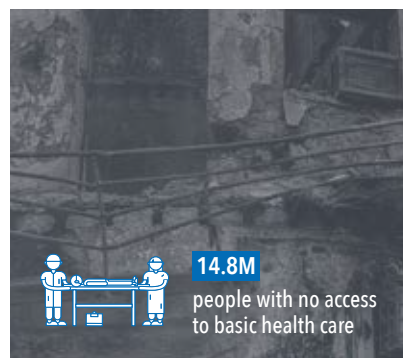

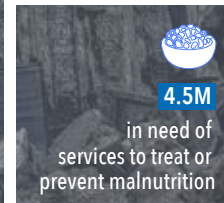

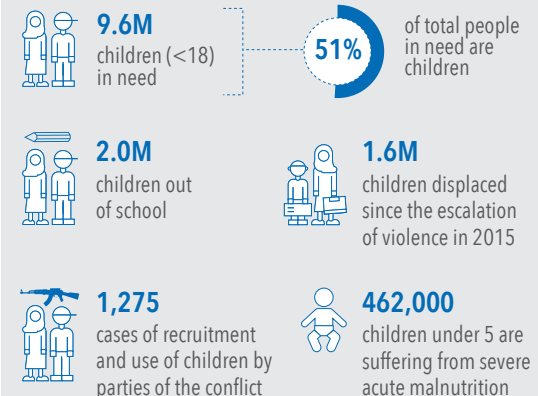
